Financial support for MASc and PhD students is usually a combination of:

- Research Assistantship/Research Stipend (RA) Paid to the student on a monthly basis on the 28th of each month from their supervisor's grants.
- **ChemE Fellowship (CEF)** Students within the funded cohort (see tables above) are considered for the CEF, no application is required.
- Scholarships
- Teaching Assistantship (TA)

Departmental Awards — When Departmental Awards are valued at less than \$3,000, students will receive the full amount of the award above their base funding. Those receiving Departmental Awards valued at \$3,000 or more, will receive \$3,000 above the base funding, with the remaining amounts being applied to the base funding.

Other Awards - Funding for students receiving external awards not listed above and valued at \$10,000 or more will be treated in the same way as HATCH. Smaller awards will be treated in the same way as Departmental Awards.

Teaching Assistantships - Whenever possible, students will be assigned to work up to 100 **Teaching Assistantship** hours (approximately \$4,700). Students must apply to available positions to be eligible.

External awards – These awards are applied to the guaranteed funding. Students receiving these awards, however, can expect to receive a top-up to the guaranteed funding of \$2,000-\$5,000, depending on the award as outlined in the tables above.
